#### **Business Name Registration**

A business name other than your personal name of the owner must be registered with Ministry of Government Services. It can be done for \$60 online and you will be immediately be issued with a Master Business License. For an additional \$8, a name search can be conducted. Online registration is available at <u>www.ontario.ca</u> with a credit card and the license can be printed off immediately. Registration can also be done in person with an additional charge of \$20.

#### Goods and Services Tax

Any business with sales of \$30,000 in 4 subsequent calendar quarters is required to register for HST. A HST registration must collect tax on most sales and remit to the federal government, but is also entitled to an Input Tax Credit or HST Paid out on business expenses. Registration can be made anytime voluntarily.

#### Business Number (BN)

The BN is issued by the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) to a business when you register four CRA accounts: HST, Payroll Deductions, Import/Export and Corporate Income Tax. #### **Employment Standards**

Employers are required to follow the Employment Standards Act that applies to hours of work, wages, leave, holidays, etc. the Employer's Guide and other helpful publications on the ESA from publications Ontario at 1-800-668-9938 or on the Ministry of Labour site at <u>www.labour.gov.on.ca/english/es</u>

#### Worker's Safety & Insurance Board (WSIB)

It is required by law to register with WSIB within 10 days of hiring an employee. Premiums are based on the industry sector in which your business operates. Their website is <u>www.wsib.on.ca</u>


