ABOUT TRENVAL

Trenval Business Development Corporation (Trenval) is a not-for-profit Community Futures organization that stimulates economic development, diversity and employment opportunities throughout our catchment area (City of Belleville, City of Quinte West, Town of Deseronto, Municipality of Stirling-Rawdon, Tyendinaga Township and First Nations Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte) by providing an array of community and business development, counselling and lending services.

Trenval operates under a contribution agreement with the <u>Federal Economic Development Agency</u> <u>for Southern Ontario (FedDev Ontario)</u> to provide Community Futures programming to these communities.

The Community Futures Program is a national, rural community, economic development initiative. Community Futures Development Corporations provide **business loans** and other business financing to small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs). They also provide **business counselling** and education services and offer access to business resources and assistance with starting a new business. Finally, CFDCs work with local businesses, not for profits, municipalities and first nations as well as provincial, regional or county governments on a wide variety of **community economic capacity development** planning and projects.
